 $Other\ Information: The\ task\ of\ this\ Tender\ is\ the\ implementation\ of\ a\ new\ tolling\ system\ on\ Corridor\ VIII+.$

Corridor VIII+ is defined as the Corridor VIII, according to the definition of the pan European corridors, as well as the highway section Miladinovci-Stip (A3e) and the highway section (A2/ E65) Kicevo- Ohrid. On Corridor VIII+ five already Existing Toll Stations (Miladinovci, Glumovo, Zjelino,

Tetovo and Gostivar) are located and three New Toll Stations (Kadrifakovo, Preod and Arbinovo) are going to be constructed. The Existing Toll Stations were upgraded some years ago, and now they have to be equipped with state-of-the-art-tolling-technology to make sure that the tolling systems on Corridor X and Corridor VIII+ are interoperable.

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
