GENERAL PROCUREMENT NOTICE

This notice updates the previous General Procurement Notices for this project published on the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development (the Bank) website on 15 October 2012 referenced 6818-GPN-39311.

The Public Enterprise for State Roads (PESR) of FYR Macedonia intends using the saving from proceeds of a loan from the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development [The Bank] to finance five new elements which will contribute towards an improvement of road safety on the selected sections. The total estimated cost of Euro 3.6 million equivalents will require the procurement of the following contracts:

1. Rehabilitation of the Regional Road R2340 between Klepac and Novaci;
2. Procurement and placement of traffic signs, road marking and equipment on 4 national roads;
3. Installation of Road Lighting at Six Regional Road Interchanges;
4. Installation of Improved Road Lighting Control System;
5. Digital archive strategy study.

Tendering for the abovementioned contracts will start in the second quarter of 2015.

Contracts to be financed with the proceeds of a loan from the Bank will be subject to Bank's procurement Policies and Rules and will be open to firms from any country. The proceeds of the Bank's loan will not be used for the purpose of any payment to persons or entities, or for any import of goods, if such payment or import is prohibited by a decision of the United Nation Council taken under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations or under a law of official regulation of the Purchaser's country.
